## LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

CCC's Leadership Development Program (LDP) engages Jewish teens in grades 8-12 in meaningful and interactive community service. At our monthly sessions, we teach critical leadership skills and provide hands-on volunteer opportunities at CCC's community-outreach programs. With four locations around Atlanta, the 2024 cohort includes 296 teens.

Our LDP curriculum includes:

- Community-building & Jewish leadership
- Empathetic volunteering
- Fundraising skills
- Program planning & implementation

CCC serves thousands of children and families and creates hundreds of teen volunteer opportunities annually across Atlanta.
